MATERIALS:

Masonite Drawing Board

approximately 16"x20" (Home Depot)

Paper

Canson Mi Tientes Pastel Paper (one large sheet preferably black-please cut into 4 even pieces)

Eraser

Kneaded eraser

Pastel Pencils

(preferably Carbothello) biggest assortment your wallet can afford

Soft Pastels

(preferably Sennelier) (NOT oil pastels) biggest assortment your wallet can afford

BRING FROM HOME:

Masking tape

18" ruler

18" piece of aluminum foil

18" piece of wax paper

A few big clips or clothespins

RECOMMENDED PURCHASE LOCATION

Before first class meeting: Blick Art Materials, South Mall, Allentown
